Update the rate A monitor's refresh rate refers to how many times per second the screen can update with new image data. This is more important to play games, and you'll want to search for a monitor with an update speed of at least 144Hz if you're really serious. Most players will be satisfied with an update speed of 75Hz or more, but if you don't use your computer for games, you can opt for a lower level. Display Type: Monitor display types can be difficult to understand because there are several different types of LED displays. IPS monitors have a great color reproduction and viewing angles, so they are good for viewing video content, any work that requires precise colors and more general usage scenarios. TN monitors have worse viewing angles, but quick update rates make them perfectly suited for games. Resolution : The resolution refers to the number of pixels that the monitor can display, which affects the sharpness and clarity of the image.
